The Right Solution

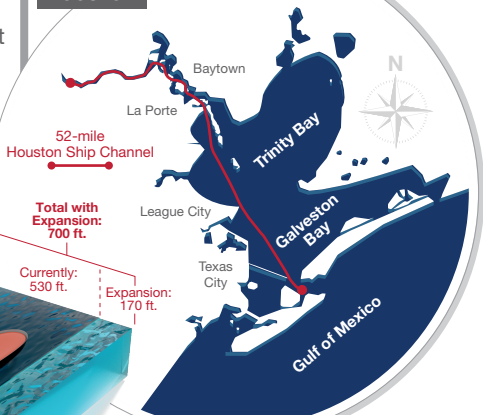
- Widening the entire Bay Reach and additional channel improvements are essential to safety and growth of regional and national commerce
